Shimla-171002, the 9th July, 1992

No. STV (TE) F (5)-11/89. —The Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to order the issue of rules and procedure for regulating the award payment of scholarships for undergoing Engineering/Polytechnic courses, as contained in Annexure 'A', as under:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(i) These rules may be called the Technical Education Scholarship Rules, 1991.

(ii) These rules shall come into force with immediate effect

2. *Repeal and savings.*—The Scholarship Rules, notified vide Public Works Department, Notification No. PWB-1-B (11) 1/80, dated 17-11-1981 and subsequent amendments made by this department vide notification No. 2-28/83-STV (Stipend), dated 5-11-1984, No. 2-28/83-STV (Stipend), dated 19-7-1987, No. STV (TE) G (6) 2/87-Part-II, dated 15-3-1988, No. STV (TE) F (5) 12/89, dated 3-8-1990 and STV (TE) C (10) 1/86, dated 19-7-1991 are hereby repealed:

Provided that such repeal shall not effect the previous operation of the said rules or anything done or any action taken thereunder.

ANNEXURE-A

RULES AND PROCEDURE FOR THE AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP TO THE STUDENTS OF HIMACHAL PRADESH STUDYING IN RECOGNISED COLLEGES AND POLYTECHNICS FOR POST GRADUATE AND DIPLOMA COURSE

1. These rules may be called the Technical Education Scholarship Rules, 1991.

2. These rules shall come into force with immediate effect.

3. The number of scholarships available under these rules shall be awarded as under:—

- (a) Post graduate courses in Engineering and Technology.
- (b) Degree courses in Engineering and Technology including Architecture or any other equivalent course approved by the all India Council of Technical Education.

- (c) Diploma/Post Diploma course in Engineering and Technology including Architectural Assistantship for any other equivalent courses approved by All India Council of Technical Education.
- (d) Any other course approved by All India Council of Technical Education, Government may like to include from time to time. It will include 5% for Post Graduate students and 2% for Post Diploma students.
4. The number of scholarships shall be such as may be fixed by the Government from time to time.
5. (a) The scholarship shall be tenable for full course from the date of joining for the duration of the course and shall be awarded/renewed on year to year basis subject to satisfactory progress of the student and continued good conduct. The recommendation of the Principal or other authorised Officer of the Institute where the student is studying will be necessary for award/renewal of scholarship. If the student fails in a university examination or in the Polytechnic examination or any examinations or test while undergoing the course which prevents him/her from being promoted to the next higher class, the scholarship shall be discontinued. However, two failures will not result in the extension in the total period of the course.
- (b) The students who are not awarded scholarships from the date of joining of course i.e. in first year can also be considered for award of scholarships in subsequent years in case number of scholarships are available due to drop outs, failure or otherwise, in particular year shall not be exceeded. These scholarships shall be awarded on the basis of the performance of previous annual examination they have passed in the Engineering course. Other conditions of award of fresh/renewal of scholarships will remain operative as at present in vogue.
6. The scholarship shall be awarded on the following basis:—
 - (i) Poverty-cum-Brilliance.
 - (ii) Brilliance.
7. The scholarships under poverty-cum-brilliance shall be awarded only if the total income from all sources of parents or guardian is not more than Rs. 1500/- per annum. The income of guardian shall be taken into account only if the parents of the scholar are not alive.
8. The scholarship shall be awarded strictly according to merit to be determined with reference to (i) income of parents/guardian and (ii) marks obtained in the examination of the class by virtue of which a candidate becomes eligible for admission to the course conducted by a recognised University/Board of School Education, provided the student has secured at least 60% marks in the said examination. This condition will however not be applicable to the scheduled castes as their merit will be judged amongst themselves.
9. The students who become eligible for scholarships on the basis of poverty-cum-brilliance shall first be awarded scholarships. After their list is exhausted, the remaining scholarships shall be awarded on the basis of brilliance.
10. (i) All students belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe and those belonging to Antodya families studying in Post Graduate degree and other courses i.e. diploma, shall get the scholarship and it will be over and above the sanctioned scholarships for these categories.
- (ii) The scholarships shall also be reserved for any other categories by Himachal Pradesh Government from time to time. The percentage of those scholarships shall be fixed by the Government.
11. The scholarship reserved for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe or any other category notified by Himachal Pradesh Government, if remained unutilised, because of non-availability of eligible candidates or otherwise, shall be considered de-reserved and shall be awarded to student of open category. Similarly, if number of scholarships earmarked for post graduate and post diploma students remain unutilised, the same shall be given to degree and diploma students respectively.
12. The scholarship will be restricted to the students who join courses in Himachal Pradesh or are nominated by Himachal Pradesh Government or selected through Regional Engineering College, Hamirpur for courses outside the Himachal Pradesh or to those who seek admission in the Engineering College, through competitive examination on all India basis for courses which are through available in Himachal Pradesh subject to the condition that their merit will be determined on the basis of minimum qualifications laid down to appear in the competitive examination to Engineering courses. Students for other courses which are not available within Himachal Pradesh shall also be eligible even if they are studying outside Himachal Pradesh. The courses available within Himachal Pradesh mean the courses which are offered in the Engineering Colleges/Polytechnics/Institutions located in Himachal Pradesh.
13. Students getting scholarships from other sources or under some other scheme shall not be eligible for grant of the same under these rules.
14. The application for the award of scholarship, should be submitted in the prescribed proforma to the Director of Technical Education, Sundernagar through the Principal or other authorised officer of the Institution where the student is studying. The Director, Technical Education, Sundernagar shall be the sanctioning authority.
15. The Students applying for poverty-cum-brilliance scholarship furnish a certificate of monthly income of parents/guardian in the prescribed form duly attested by a Magistrate or Tehsildar. Students applying for brilliance scholarship need not submit income certificate.
16. The applications complete in all respects should reach the prescribed authority by the date fixed for the purpose. Applications which are not received within the prescribed date or are incomplete and not in the manner prescribed above, would not be entertained.
17. The students belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and those belonging to Antodya families or any other reserved category notified by Himachal Pradesh Government for award of such scholarships should furnish a certificate duly signed by Magistrate first class or Tehsildar as the case may be, in support of the fact that he/she is a member of such category. This certificate shall be furnished along with application form.
18. Only those students shall be eligible for the award of scholarships who are bonafide Himachalies and ward of Himachal Pradesh Government employees.
19. The value of scholarship for post graduate/degree courses will be Rs. 200/- p.m. The value of a scholarship for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe and Antodya family students undergoing post graduate degree courses will be Rs. 400/- p.m. The enhanced value of scholarship for S. C., S. T. and Antodya families students shall be effective from the academic session, 1991-92. Diploma courses students including those of Antodya families will continue to get/will get scholarship at the rate of Rs. 100/- p.m.
20. All students who are awarded scholarships under these rules shall be required to execute a bond to the effect that they will serve Himachal Pradesh for a period of at least five years after the completion of their course, if their services are required by the State Government.
21. All previous rules and procedure issued from time to time by the Himachal Pradesh Public Works Department and Technical Education Department prior to these
